RESPONSE TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA'S FIREARMS CONTROL EFFORTS

For immediate release

On 16th January 2013, Mr. Barack Obama, head of the *de facto* United States regime, issued a series of twenty-three unilateral directives in direct violation of that country's *de jure* contract with its people established in their Constitution, which clearly states that the rights of the people to keep and bear arms shall not be infringed.

We condemn these directives, together with the racist, vindictive and inflaming rhetoric made against Southerners this week by legislators of the nationalist United States government, as being counter to the welfare and benefit of both the people of the United States and our citizens in the still occupied Southern States. We remind these northern gentlemen that the right to keep and bear arms is the practical foundation upon which Liberty is built and the enemy of all who seek totalitarianism.

We applaud the actions of officials in the sovereign States of Texas, South Carolina, Kentucky and Alabama for their public and outspoken refusals to comply with the unlawful dictates of Mr. Obama. We support the efforts of legislators in South Carolina, Arkansas and Oklahoma, who immediately introduced nullification bills and other opposition legislation.

We approve the efforts of ordinary citizens who responded to Mr. Obama's dictates by securing the means to protect their families, lives and property.

We salute the many private organizations whose members work tirelessly to secure the Liberties of free men in the American States, most notably the League of the South, the National Rifle Association, the Southern Nationalist News and the ladies and gentlemen of the United Daughters of the Confederacy and the Sons of Confederate Veterans.

Beginning Sunday, 20th January 2013, and every Sunday thereafter, the Confederate States government asks that every Southerner display a Confederate Third National flag, the official flag of the Confederate States, outside their home, church and business as a statement of opposition to the efforts of the Obama government to usurp the rights of Americans to keep and bear arms. In areas where it is not safe to freely display your flag, one's State flag should be displayed. We also ask that you remember to pray each Sunday for the men and women who are at the fore in this fight against our oppressors in Washington.
